

Governing the Distribution of the Elsbeth E. Santee Scholarship Fund

Rules and Regulations

1. The applicant must be a student attending California University of Pennsylvania and majoring in one of the Foreign Languages offered at this university—in the College of Liberal Arts, in the College of Education & Human Services, or in the International Studies—Foreign Languages Program.
2. A Student may apply for this Scholarship as a:
 - 1) Sophomore (second semester)
 - 2) Junior
 - 3) Senior
3. The applicant must have attained a QPA of 3.0 in the foreign language major and an overall QPA of 3.0. Character, Personality, Responsibility, and Dependability, are other factors that will be considered.
4. When scholarship applications are made, the student must present an essay in which he/she will give an insight into his/her educational goals and career aspirations. It is important that your statements project an accurate portrait of you as an individual. The essay must be directed to answering the questions below. Be sure that your responses are grammatically correct and in good form, but most of all, be sincere and honest.
 - A) What are your career aspirations?
 - B) Why should you be considered for this scholarship?
 - C) Why is higher education important to you?
 - D) Who was the most influential person in your life?
5. All members of faculty as individuals and/or as a group may request an interview of the applicant(s).
6. After a thorough review of the application(s), the Foreign Language Department as a whole will designate the recipient(s) of the scholarship(s).
7. A maximum amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) will be granted to any one individual should there be no others who have applied or have met the requirements. Should there be more than one qualifying applicant, the Scholarship monies that are available will be shared equally by up to four recipients.
8. Any change of major from Foreign Languages to any other will require the return of the scholarship funds received.
9. This scholarship can only be applied toward courses taken at California University of Pennsylvania.
10. The application deadline will be the first (1st) of April of each year. The scholarship is applicable in the fall semester of the same year.
